<p><b>ONLINE APPLICATION + dorm application</b></p> <p><b>Online Learning Agreement</b></p>	<p>The application process starts with filling the <b>ON-LINE APPLIATION FORM</b>, which includes <b>application for the dormitory</b>. The next step is filling the OLA. All necessary information on the application process is available on the university website: <a href="https://zagranica.wum.edu.pl/node/13468">https://zagranica.wum.edu.pl/node/13468</a></p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> number of available places per course is limited. Therefore, you should be aware of possible necessity for modifications of your study program.</p>
<p><b>Language of instruction</b></p>	<p>The <b>main language of instruction at MUW is Polish</b>. It is our pleasure to host students speaking Polish, who can attend classes together with Polish students. We also offer programmes for <b>Medicine and Dentistry in English</b>, which are chosen by most exchange students. The nominated students are required to have the language command of English at minimum B2 level.</p>
<p><b>PROGRAM OF STUDY – Medicine</b></p>	<p><b>The syllabus for the medical curriculum in English is available on the website:</b> <a href="https://ed.wum.edu.pl/node/1009">https://ed.wum.edu.pl/node/1009</a></p> <p>We offer a 6-year medical program to our exchange students. Courses can be chosen from different years of study.</p> <p><b>Before the beginning of the semester each exchange student creates his/her INDIVIDUAL TIMETABLE based on the English Medical Programme timetables. Modifications of the learning agreement caused by overlaps, unavailability of courses are possible!</b></p>
<p><b>PROGRAM OF STUDY – other faculties</b></p>	<p><b>Dentistry:</b> exchange students join our domestic students for courses in English (only courses of one year can be chosen)</p> <p><b>Pharmacy:</b> exchange students participate in research projects in English</p> <p><b>Nursing/Midwifery/Nutrition/Public health:</b> practical classes in English are organised according to a fixed programme proposed before the beginning of each semester</p>
<p><b>Accommodation</b></p>	<p><b>Application for the dorm is integrated with the student application for ERASMUS mobility – separate housing application is not needed.</b> ‘First come first served’ rule is applied based on the order of the online registration.</p> <p>The university provides fully furnished and equipped double rooms with kitchen and bathroom in the university residence - Dom Studenta BIS 2, ul. Karolkowa 84. (The university will provide you with guidance on searching for accommodation in Warsaw in case of problems with getting a room in the student residence.)</p> <p>The deposit will be required upon arrival in cash. <p><b>Insurance &amp; Student Card</b></p>	<p>Each exchange student is obliged to possess health insurance. For EU/EFTA citizens <b>European Health Insurance Card</b> is required. The students from non-EU/EEA countries need to purchase health insurance in their home country, before departure. Medical care is not free of charge for foreign citizens (except the EU/EEA citizens, see above). Health insurance will cover your private medical care.</p> <p>For <b>non EU/EFTA</b> citizens (e.g. Turkey) a <b>private health insurance is necessary</b>. Make sure that the agreement with insurance company ensures reimbursement of costs of treatment abroad.</p> <p><b>ISIC – International Student Identity Card</b> is also recommended for all international students. It covers additional insurance – health, liability, accident –</p>
